The Faith of a Fourth Grader: In their faith journey, fourth graders enjoy learning about the heroes of the Bible and the stories of the People of God. - Delight in retelling and acting out stories from the Bible

- Appreciate and understand at a deeper level the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation
- Strive to incorporate good works into daily living
- Like participating in community service
