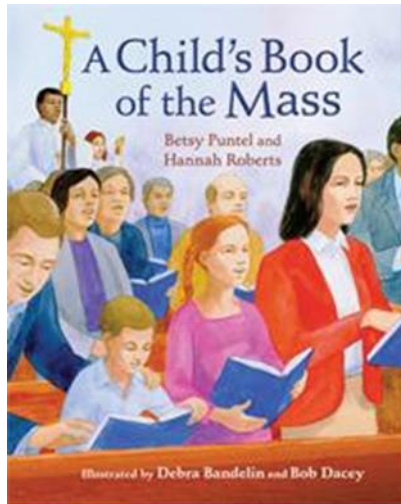


We rejoice with our friend, Betsy Puntel on the publication of her first book for children entitled,
A Child's Book of the Mass.

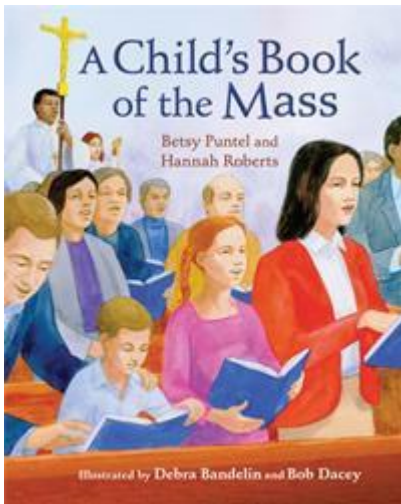


Betsy Puntel led the Level I and Level II Good Shepherd Certification courses which took place at Assumption.

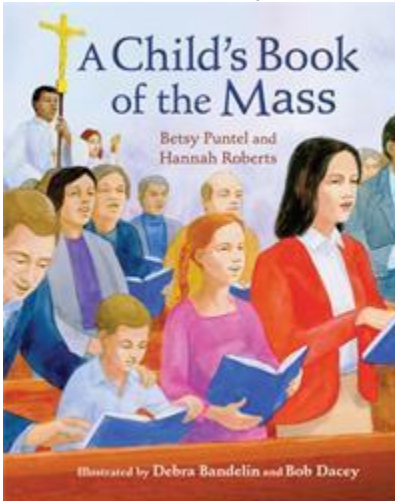

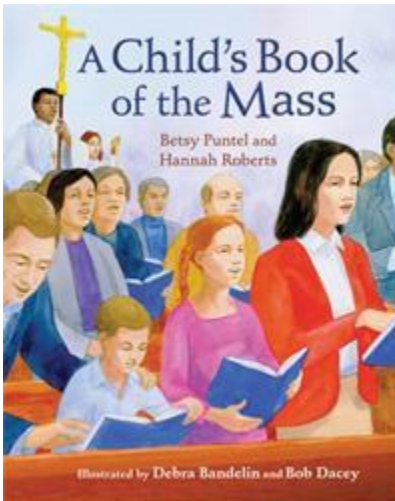
