9/17/17	<b>Orientation:</b> Candidate/Parent Meeting	-To become familiar with the preparation process and meet the Catechists and their class.
10/8/17	<b>Mental Health Matters</b>	-Mandatory presentation for parents/candidates held after the 5:30 youth mass from 6:30-8pm in the church.
10/22/17	<b>Life is Choices:</b>	-To remind candidates that they make hundreds of choices every day and that every choice has consequences. -To help candidates become better decision makers. -To demonstrate how God's way and the way of the world are very different, and invite candidates to choose to walk with God.
11/5/17	<b>What's holding you back?</b>	-To demonstrate that all paths are not equal and that there is such a thing as objective truth. -To teach candidates to recognize patterns of <i>stinking thinking</i> in their lives. -To help candidates recognize who and what is holding them back from living the incredible life God invites them to.
12/17/17	<b>The Jesus Question:</b>	-Encourage candidates to rediscover Jesus and to reassess the role he should be playing in their lives. -To teach candidates that Jesus and his teachings are the answer to the problems we face in our lives and in the world. .To help candidates recognize the power and importance of having a personal relationship with Jesus.
